Student Council Application

What is Student Council at Sycamore Creek?

Student Council is an opportunity for 3rd, 4th and 5th graders at Sycamore Creek to take an active role school-wide programs and service projects. Student Council members will meet for monthly meetings after school. Additional meetings are scheduled as needed. While representing Sycamore Creek, these student leaders will gain responsibility and will demonstrate pride in our school community.

Election Process:

- TRACKS 1,2,& 4: Applications are due to classroom teachers by Friday, August 7th. Elections will be held sometime between Monday, August 10th and Friday, August 14th. (Determined by classroom teacher.)
- Candidate Speeches: Once candidates have turned in an application, they will be given two minutes to make a speech in front of their homeroom class. Students are not allowed to campaign (create stickers, posters, buttons, etc.). This is to ensure fairness throughout the election. Students can use their application essay as their speech, but are encouraged to come up with something more creative (song, poem, or something else!) We also encourage students to dress nicely. This year, props are allowed during speeches. Each class will then vote on one representative the student with the majority of votes will win the class election.
- IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS: When considering this opportunity for your child, please have a
 conversation about how only one person gets chosen per class. This is NOT a reason to turn down the
 opportunity to run. Much can be learned from defeat sometimes even more than a victory.
- First Meeting: Our first class council meeting will be held on Thursday, August 27th. Please see the back for a tentative meeting schedule. All students will need to bring ten dollars to the first meeting to contribute towards the cost of a student council t-shirt. The opportunity to run for officer positions (President, Vice President, Secretary & Historian) will also be presented during the our meeting.

- 5. Class representatives are **proud to be a Sycamore Creek Crocodile**, and work to make our school better each day. They encourage classmates to participate in school-wide events and projects.
