Monday 7/27 - Friday 7/31: Share a little bit about student council with your class!

- We are a group of student-leaders who strive to make an impact on our school and community! We meet monthly and work on service projects. This year we're planning to facilitate two school-wide projects (including a food drive) and several smaller projects.
- Distribute applications to interested students on Friday, July 31st. Send home in Friday Folders!
 Completed student applications are due back to classroom teachers on Friday, August 7th.
- Student council members ALWAYS CHOMP! They are leaders in the school and in their classrooms.

*Note to teachers: Students may need permission during morning arrival (on the Monday and Tuesday you track back in) to visit previous classroom teachers for their recommendation signatures.

Wednesday, August 19th: Student Council Applications Due

- Collect applications in class. Remind students they will not receive applications back, so they'll need to keep another copy of their essay if they plan to use it as a speech.
- Please turn in all applications to Ms. McHenry's box by 4:00 PM. Or, just send them with a student to my classroom!

Thursday, 8/20-Tuesday, 8/25: Classroom Student Council Elections

- Choose one day between 8/20 and 8/25 to hold class elections. Procedures for the election:
 - We've decided **not to allow campaigning** (posters, signs, stickers, etc.) in order to make the election fair for all students.
 - O <u>Speeches:</u> Student can use their application essay as their speech, or come up with something more creative. This year, <u>students are allowed to use props.</u> They may use note cards or read from a piece of paper. (Not necessary for speeches to be memorized.)
 - O Each candidate should be given 2 minutes to speak in front of the class.
 - O Allow each class member 1 vote. Collect the votes -- majority wins the election. If there is a tie, hold a run-off election between the tie-holders. If you'd like, you may allow tie-holders to speak for an additional minute in front of the class.
